Internship description

To ensure a smooth transition and to continuously improve our digital presence, we are looking for a digital communications intern to support us with post-launch website checks and content management. In addition, TBI manages a large online photo library that is due for restructuring. The intern will contribute to exploring and implementing a more effective system for organizing and maintaining this visual archive. You will be part of a small but dedicated communications team working to amplify the visibility and impact of our work worldwide.

Internship activities:

- As a digital communications intern, you will support the team with tasks such as:
- Uploading, editing, and managing content on the Tropenbos International network websites
- Organizing, restructuring and managing our photo library in SharePoint
- Supporting research and implementation of Search Engine Optimization (SEO) techniques, including the use of AI tools
- Monitoring website analytics and contributing to strategies to improve results
- Exploring tools and plug-ins to increase website traffic and engagement

We're seeking an enthusiastic and proactive intern who is eager to learn and contribute to the digital communications of our TBI network. You don't need to meet every requirement—if you're interested in digital communications and ready to grow, we encourage you to apply.
